



Corvette Fun Fact: The Hidden Emblem That Almost Wasn't

Did you know the Corvette's iconic crossed-flags emblem nearly had a very different look?

When Chevrolet was designing the Corvette in 1953, the original plan for the badge included the American flag alongside a checkered racing flag—a nod to the car's U.S. roots and performance pedigree. But there was a hitch: using the American flag for commercial purposes was illegal at the time.

Just days before the Corvette's debut at the 1953 Motorama show in New York, the team scrambled to redesign the emblem. They swapped the American flag for a fleur-de-lis, a symbol tied to Chevrolet's French heritage (thanks to founder Louis Chevrolet), and added a bowtie logo for brand flair. The result? The sleek, timeless crossed-flags badge we know and love today, which has adorned every Corvette since.

Next time you're polishing your Vette's emblem, give a nod to that last-minute save—it's proof that even under pressure, Corvette style always comes out on top!

REVVED-UP RECIPES

Food for the Corvette Soul

Raspberry Bars

Nothing says "cruisin' in style" like a dessert that's as bold and vibrant as your favorite Corvette! Our Corvette Raspberry Bars are a sweet treat with a tart raspberry kick, layered to mimic the sleek lines of a Vette. Perfect for sharing at our next club meetup or enjoying after a scenic drive. Let's bake some speed!

Ingredients (Makes 12 bars):

- For the Crust:
 - 1 ½ cups graham cracker crumbs
 - 1/4 cup granulated sugar
 - ½ cup unsalted butter, melted
- For the Filling:
 - 1 ½ cups fresh raspberries (or frozen, thawed)
 - ½ cup raspberry jam
 - 8 oz cream cheese, softened
 - ½ cup powdered sugar
 - 1 tsp vanilla extract
- For the Topping:
 - ½ cup white chocolate chips, melted
 - Red food coloring (optional, for a "redline" effect)



Instructions:

- Build the Chassis: Preheat your oven to 350°F (175°C). In a bowl, mix the graham cracker crumbs, sugar, and melted butter until combined. Press the mixture into an 8x8-inch baking pan lined with parchment paper. Bake for 8 minutes, then let it cool slightly.
- Add the Horsepower: In a blender, puree the raspberries until smooth. Strain to remove seeds if desired. In a separate bowl, beat the cream cheese, powdered sugar, and vanilla until creamy. Fold in the raspberry puree and jam, creating a vibrant red filling. Spread this evenly over the cooled crust.
- Finish with Flair: Melt the white chocolate chips and add a drop of red food coloring for a "redline" streak (optional). Drizzle over the raspberry layer in sleek, diagonal lines to mimic a racing stripe. Chill in the fridge for at least 2 hours to set.
- Take the Victory Lap: Slice into bars and serve! These treats are as eye-catching as a freshly waxed Vette, with a sweet-tart flavor that'll have everyone asking for seconds.
