



We're diving into a fascinating piece of Vette history that celebrates the spirit of innovation and performance. Let's hit the road!

The Birth of the Mid-Engine Dream: 1970 XP-882

This month, we spotlight the 1970 Chevrolet Corvette XP-882, a groundbreaking experimental prototype that foreshadowed the mid-engine revolution in Corvette design. Unveiled as a concept car, the XP-882 was Chevrolet's bold attempt to explore a mid-engine layout, a design philosophy that would eventually define the C8 generation. Powered by a 400-cubic-inch V8 engine producing around 370 horsepower, this sleek prototype featured a low, aerodynamic body crafted from fiberglass, with the engine positioned behind the driver for improved weight



distribution and handling—a stark departure from the front-engine tradition of the time.

Only two XP-882 models were built, making it an exceedingly rare piece of Corvette lore. Though it never reached production due to cost and engineering challenges, the XP-882's influence lingered, inspiring engineers like Zora Arkus-Duntov to push for mid-engine designs. Fast forward to 2020, when the C8 Corvette debuted with its mid-engine configuration, a direct nod to this visionary prototype. For SCVCC members, the XP-882 is a reminder of how our beloved Vettes have evolved, blending heritage with cutting-edge innovation—a legacy we carry on every cruise.

This historical gem inspires us as we gear up for September events. The General Meeting on September 4th at Santa Clarita Lanes is the perfect venue to discuss Corvette milestones, while the Family Night on September 12th at Route 66 Classic Grill and the Cold Springs Tavern Cruise on September 13th offer chances to admire our rides. As we plan for the Santa Barbara Polo Club outing on September 7th, let's celebrate the XP-882's role in shaping the Vette's future.

#### Food for the Corvette Soul

#### Corvette Autumn Apple Crisp


As the Santa Clarita Valley Corvette Club (SCVCC) cruises into September 2025, we're bringing a warm, seasonal treat to fuel your Vette adventures! This easy-to-make dish combines the crispness of apples with a nod to the open road—let's get cooking!

#### Ingredients (Serves 8):

- 6 cups apples (Granny Smith or Honeycrisp), peeled, cored, and sliced
- 1 tbsp lemon juice
- 1/3 cup granulated sugar
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp nutmeg
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 cup old-fashioned oats
- 3/4 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter, cold and cubed
- 1/4 tsp salt
- Vanilla ice cream (optional, for serving)

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Prep the Track: Preheat your oven to 350°F (175°C). Toss the sliced apples with lemon juice, granulated sugar, cinnamon, and nutmeg in a 9x13-inch baking dish. Spread evenly to create your base layer.
- 2. Build the Finish Line: In a bowl, combine flour, oats, brown sugar, and salt. Cut in the cold butter with a pastry blender or your fingers until the mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Sprinkle this topping evenly over the apples.
- 3. Cruise to Perfection: Bake for 40-45 minutes, or until the topping is golden brown and the apples are tender and bubbling. The aroma will fill your kitchen like a Vette on a scenic drive!
- 4. Cross the Finish Line: Let cool slightly, then serve warm. Add a scoop of vanilla ice cream for a cool contrast—perfect for a post-cruise treat!
